An amendment to Board File F – Facility Construction

Insert the following new section:

Board File FBA – Restroom Facility Design, Construction, and Renovation

The Platte County R-3 School District Board of Education is responsible for providing guidance to the Superintendent regarding the design, construction, and renovation of district facilities, including the design, construction, and renovation of restrooms that are used by students, staff, and visitors.

Regarding the development of any new district facility or the renovation of any existing facility, the Superintendent is required to design and construct Multiple Occupancy Restrooms and Changing Areas. In addition, when necessary, the Superintendent is authorized to design and construct Single Occupancy Restrooms or Changing Areas as a reasonable accommodation for any student, staff, or visitor that does not want to use a Multiple Occupancy Restroom or Changing Area.

Definitions

Multiple Occupancy Restroom or Changing Area – Any room or area designated for use by more than one individual student at a time, where students may be in various stages of undress in the presence of other students or individuals. The term may include, but is not limited to, a school restroom, locker room, changing room, or shower room.

Reasonable Accommodation – Reasonable accommodation includes the use of a single occupancy restroom or changing area, accommodation determined as part of Section 504 or IEP requirement, or any other reasonable accommodation as required by law.

Single Occupancy Restroom or Changing Area – Any room or area designated for use by only one person, having only one toilet and a locking door, or any room or area designated to be used by one student at a time, where a student may be in various stages of undress. The term may include, but is not limited to, a single use restroom, single use changing room, or single use restroom with a shower.
