TEACHING & LEARNING SYSTEM

- Improve student achievement for ALL students as measured by overall student performance data, sub group performance data, and market value assets.
- Cultivate an environment of inclusion and equity for ALL students as measured by sub group data, attendance, graduation, discipline, survey data, participation data, and performance data.



IMPROVEMENT ACTIONS

Teaching and Learning System Enhancements

- Creation of a single guidance document
- Increased consistency in processes for movement between Tiers

Special Education

- Communication enhancements
- Life Skills lab and post graduation programming
- Professional Development

English Learners

- Refinement of identification processes and programming for Newcomers versus existing caseloads
- Identification and closing of instructional gaps and instructional delivery



IMPROVEMENT ACTIONS

LEAP (Gifted)

- High School Programming and Support
- FastBridge Universal Screening shifts for identification
- Collaboration on acceleration planning outside the LEAP classroom

Early Learning (PAT, ECSE, Tuition)

- Alignment of processes
- Exploration of At Risk programming
- LETRS and new curriculum implementation

Reading Improvement/Math Improvement

- Shift in identification procedures
- Pilot of Math Interventionists (Pathfinder, Barry, PCMS)
- Ongoing PD for leveraging data to improve instruction



IMPROVEMENT ACTIONS

- Development of a district-wide behavioral approach
 - Safe and Civil Schools training (began in 2018) Tier I & 2a
 - STOIC (essential components of effective behavior management, framework to identify strengths and areas for improvement)
 - Behavior Coach professional development
 - Behavior intervention planning (Tier 2b and 3)
